PLEASE READ AND RETAIN THIS PORTION OF THE FORM FOR YOUR RECORDS.

- Museum Family Memberships and higher receive a \$15 discount.
- Payment and signed release form must accompany completed registration form.
- Doors open 5 minutes prior to class and close 5 minutes after class, supervision is not provided outside of class times.
- Please alert us in advance of any special needs, allergies, etc. that apply to your child.
- Please bring a labeled large T-shirt, apron, or smock to use as a cover-up.
- All students need to bring a healthy snack from home. There are no vending machines at the Museum.
- Students participating in the 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. classes have two options: bring a lunch that will not require refrigeration or heating, or purchase a lunch from The Palette Café by Viking.
- Cell phones, i-pods, MP3 players, trading cards, toys, etc. are not allowed at The Museum School. They can be disruptive and very distracting.
- Special needs/medications: The Museum tries to accommodate all interested children. We ask that you speak to Museum staff in advance of class about any special needs or medications your child might have. It is our policy to administer only life-saving, emergency medications such as epi-pens and rescue inhalers. If your child has other medications, we ask you administer them before class. Staff is not permitted to administer daily medications. Any emergency medications must be accompanied by the appropriate paperwork and signed forms by your doctor, and must be in their original containers.

Refund Policy: Refunds are available with two weeks' notification; a \$10 service fee will be applied to all refunds.

Class sizes are limited.

Mini Matisse

2-4 year olds - Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday mornings - 10-11:30 - \$70 per week

June 8-10 AND/OR June 15-17 AND/OR July 27-29 AND/OR August 3-5

Different classes are offered each session. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Introduce your budding artist to the Museum and the world of art through age appropriate gallery activities, hands-on art projects, art games, and art books. Bring your imagination and dress for mess!

Little Masters

5, 6, 7 year olds or rising K-2nd graders - 5 days a week - afternoons - 1-4 - \$165 per week

June 7-11 AND/OR July 26-30 - 2-D (two dimensional) Weeks

June 14-18 AND/OR August 2-6 (3-D (three dimensional) Weeks

Different classes are offered each session.

2-D Week 1 - Focus on drawing and printmaking

2-D Week 2 - Focus on color design and painting techniques

3-D Week 1 - Focus on pottery and relief sculpture

3-D Week 2 - Focus on sculpture - wire, found objects, paper mache

Each camp includes 1) a presentation/demonstration by a working artist featured in our Museum collection, 2) in depth tour of the Museum, 3) student art exhibition

Young Artists

8, 9, 10 year olds or rising 3-5th graders - 5 days a week - all day - 9-4 - \$235 per week

June 7-11 OR July 19-23 - 2-D (two dimensional) Weeks

June 14-18 OR July 26-30 - 3-D (three dimensional) Weeks

2-D Weeks - Focus on drawing, painting, collage, printmaking

3-D Weeks - Focus on sculpture, such as clay, wire, found objects, glass, paper, wood, plaster

Each camp includes 1) a presentation/demonstration by a working artist featured in our Museum collection, 2) in depth tour of the Museum, 3) student art exhibition

Studio I, Studio II

11, 12, 13 year olds or rising 6-8th graders - 5 days a week - all day, 9-4 - \$245 per week

June 21-25 AND/ OR July 12-16

Different classes are offered each session.

Working with an artist, students take a closer look at the creative process while taking full advantage of the Museum's permanent and changing exhibitions. These classes will focus on the styles and techniques of artists. What inspires an artistic mind? How does an idea develop into a completed work?
